Inspections

- Rental dwelling buildings with 3 or more units and 50% rental are inspected annually. The inspection is of the common areas and exteriors of the buildings, and the interior of all rental dwellings is inspected over 5 years. - The exterior areas of rental dwelling buildings with less than 3 units are inspected during routine property maintenance surveys of the entire community. Interior inspections are made in response to problems reported by the public or other Village depts.
