## PRESS RELEASE

### **MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE ARREST TWO MEN FOR AGGRAVATED SPEEDING OVER THE WEEKEND IN SEPARATE INCIDENTS**

This past weekend, the Mount Prospect Police Department arrested two local men for the offense of Aggravated Speeding. Aggravated Speeding, 625 ILCS 5/11-601.5., is a Class A Misdemeanor that can be charged when a motorist exceeds a posted speed limit by 40 miles per hour or more – as was the case in both weekend offenses.

The first incident occurred on Saturday, November 20, 2010 at 3:56 PM, when a Mount Prospect Police Officer observed a vehicle travelling eastbound on Northwest Highway from Waterman Avenue, at a very high rate of speed. The officer recorded the offending vehicle's speed on radar at 101 MPH in the posted 40 MPH speed limit zone. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and arrested Paul Fudala of Mount Prospect for Aggravated Speeding (61 MPH over the posted speed limit of 40 m.p.h.).

The second incident occurred on Sunday, November 21, 2010 at 2:31 PM, when a Mount Prospect Police Officer observed a vehicle travelling eastbound on Central Road at Maple Street at a high rate of speed. The officer recorded the vehicle's speed at 80 MPH in the posted 35 MPH speed limit zone. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and arrested Roi Azulay of Arlington Heights for Aggravated Speeding (45 MPH over the posted speed limit of 40 m.p.h.).

Both subjects are scheduled to appear in the Third District Court of Cook County in Rolling Meadows in December.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
