Mount Prospect Police Conduct Alcohol Compliance Checks At Local Businesses

On July 14, 2011, the Mount Prospect Police Department conducted compliance checks on eight local businesses that have a license to sell packaged liquor within the Village. During the compliance check, a cashier from Dominick's, 1028 South Elmhurst Road, sold alcohol to a person under twenty one (21) years of age. Mexie Jackson, 24 years old, of Des Plaines was cited and charged under the Village's local ordinance with one count of selling alcohol to a person under twenty one (21) years of age. Also, a cashier from Balzano Liquors, 2316 South Elmhurst Road, sold alcohol to a person under twenty one (21) years of age. Rameshkumara Patel, 50 years old, of Mount Prospect was cited and charged under the Village's local ordinance with one count of selling liquor to a person under twenty one (21) years of age. Both cashiers are scheduled to appear in room 209 of the 3rd District Court of Cook County in Rolling Meadows at 10:30 A.M. on August 24, 2011.

While conducting a compliance check at Jay's Liquor, 1728 West Dempster Street, a Mount Prospect Police Department Investigator observed Jose Gonzalez, 42 year old, of Arlington Heights purchase a bottle of vodka and deliver it to a male in a vehicle who appeared to be under the age of twenty one (21). The investigator approached both subjects and learned the male in the vehicle, Kei Glaser, 18 year old of Rolling Meadows, to be under 21 years old. Gonzalez was cited and charged under the Village's local ordinance with one count of delivering alcohol to a person under the age of 21. Glaser was cited and charged under the Village's local ordinance with one count of possession of alcohol while under the age of 21. Both subjects are scheduled to appear in room 209 of the 3rd District Court of Cook County in Rolling Meadows at 10:30 A.M. on August 24, 2011.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
