MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE INVESTIGATE TRAFFIC CRASH INVOLVING A VEHICLE AND A PEDESTRIAN

On Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at approximately 10:11 p.m., the Mount Prospect Police responded to a report of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle near the intersection of Elmhurst Road (Route 83) and LaSalle Street.

Upon arrival at the scene, officers found the pedestrian being treated by the Des Plaines Fire Department in the curb lane of southbound Elmhurst Road, south of the intersection with LaSalle Street. Fire department personnel had initiated life-saving efforts and transported the pedestrian to Advocate Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge. The pedestrian, a 45-year old male of Mount Prospect, is currently still at Advocate Lutheran General Hospital.

A 36-year old Mount Prospect man was the lone occupant of the striking vehicle. He was not injured during the collision.

The Mount Prospect Police Department continues to investigate the collision and requests anyone who witnessed the crash or has any additional information to contact the department's Major Accident Investigation Team at 847-870-5656.
