The Mayor and Village Board (consisting of six (6) trustees) are elected at-large to staggered, four (4) year terms by the residents of the community.

Mount Prospect operates under the Council/Manager form of government. Under the Council-Manager form, power is concentrated in the elected council, which hires a professional Village Manager to implement its policies. The appointed Manager administers daily operations within the community, while the elected Village President and Board of Trustees determine Village policy. The Village Manager serves at the pleasure of the council and has responsibility for preparing the budget, directing day-to-day operations, hiring and firing personnel and serving as the council's chief policy advisor.

Mount Prospect is a home rule community with authority to act independently on all legislative matter not in conflict with state or federal laws. The Village is governed by the ordinances passed by the Village Board pursuant to home rule powers.

Along with the Village Manager's office, several different departments and divisions including Community Development, Finance, Fire, Human Resources, Human Services, Information Technology, Police, Public Works, Television Services and the Village Clerk handle the day-to-day service of the Village. The departments are staffed by professionals with the foremost training and education and are highly recognized in their respective fields.
