Homeowners can cover up to 60% of the cost of going solar through state and federal incentives. Throughout the Spring and Summer, the Citizens Utility Board is hosting 50+ free solar educational events as part of Solarize Chicagoland. Solarize Chicagoland is a grassroots community education program. Their aim is to empower consumers to make informed choices regarding solar energy for their homes, and make solar more accessible.

A Solar Power Hour event will be held on Tuesday, July 23, 2019 at the Mount Prospect Village Hall, 50 S. Emerson Street, in the Village Board Room from 7-8:30p.m.

This free event will help interested homeowners determine whether solar is right for them. Presentations will review the basics of solar, financials, how to tell if your site is ready for solar, and how to participate in Solarize Chicagoland.

Solarize Chicagoland is a partnership between Cook County, DuPage County, Kane County, and Will County, the Midwest Renewable Energy Association (MREA) and the Citizens Utility Board (CUB) to coordinate a solar group buy across all four counties. The advantage of a group buy is the power of volume purchasing, which can significantly reduce the up-front costs of installing solar on your home.
