1. Please purchase online at www.mountprospect.org/vehiclestickers or complete this form, return with your remittance check or money order in the envelope provided, and mail or bring the completed form to the Village of Mount Prospect, 50 South Emerson Street. **Paying online or by mail will allow you to avoid long lines at the Finance Department.** The following sticker types are NOT available for online purchase: Handicapped/Exempt Servicemen/Church-School-Park/Dealer/Rate Changes/First time Seniors. **There are 24 hour payment boxes located outside Village Hall and in the parking garage;** do not send cash. IF PAYING BY MAIL, IT IS RECOMMENDED TO MAIL YOUR APPLICATION BY APRIL 9 IN ORDER TO ENSURE RECEIPT OF YOUR STICKER PRIOR TO THE APRIL 30 DUE DATE.
2. **New Vehicles/New Residents** – Vehicle license must be displayed within 30 days after the purchase of a new vehicle or upon becoming a new resident. After 30 days, a late fee will apply. **If license plates are not received during that period, please indicate “applied for” in the area requiring a license plate number and call 847-392-6000 when you receive the plates to report the license number.** A bill of sale for the vehicle or a copy of lease or proof of closing date for home purchase is required.
3. **If you are 65 or older by April 30 of the current season** and have a valid driver’s license, a senior rate will apply for passenger cars only. Trucks are regular rate. When applying for the first time, please provide proof of age and vehicle ownership. The vehicle must be owned and operated by the senior for non-commercial use. A copy of a current driver’s license must be provided in order to obtain the senior rate. Only one senior citizen rate per family household is allowed.
4. **If you have a State of Illinois Ex- Prisoner of War, Disabled Veteran or Physically Handicapped license plate or a permanent physically handicapped placard,** one vehicle sticker is available without charge. Each time you submit a vehicle sticker application for a handicapped sticker, you must provide a copy of your vehicle registration form or handicapped placard. This provision applies to State of Illinois registrations only.
5. The applicant will be responsible for the late penalty if there are delays in issuing the sticker as a result of returning this application to the applicant for missing information or incorrect payment. No refunds will be issued after April 30.
